COVER INSTRUCTIONS

Eligibility Requirements

The ideal candidate will be a female student enrolled as a full-time student at a college or university with an accredited real estate program. Applications will also be considered if the applicant is a female student enrolled as a full-time student at an accredited college or university that does not have an accredited real estate program, but where the applicant is enrolled in business, finance, architecture, engineering, or other related field of study where it is the applicant's intent to pursue a career in commercial real estate.

- The applicant must be of junior or senior standing.
- The applicant must have maintained a minimum 3.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale.

Application Procedure

All application materials must be submitted, in their entirety, in one envelope. Applicants must complete the online application form at <http://www.crewcareerzone.org/>, submit the form online, then print the form and attach it with the completed application packet.

A complete application packet must include:

- Completed application form, including essay questions. Be sure to submit the form online, then print the form and sign the statement on the last page. Include the completed, signed form in your application packet.
- Official copies of all collegiate grade records, certified by the registrar or other qualified college official.
- Two letters of recommendation submitted in envelopes marked "Confidential" and sealed by the reference with his/her signature over the seal. References should indicate how they know the applicant and why the applicant should be considered for this award. Both letters should be from professors or employers who know the applicant's work. At least one of the letters should be from a professor in the applicable accredited real estate program or, if attending a university lacking an accredited real estate program, from a professor in the other related field of study.
